BOOKING FEE

Tickets for every performance promoted by Theatr Brycheiniog are subject to a £1.50 per ticket administration fee. This fee contributes to covering our ticket retail and secure payment processing costs.

RELAXED PERFORMANCES

These are adaptations of the show specifically designed for anyone who may find the typical theatre experience overwhelming or who would benefit from a more relaxed environment.

During a relaxed performance house lights are left on and strobe lighting is removed and loud noises are taken out or reduced. Making noise during the performance is not discouraged and the audience is free to go in and out as needed. We also provide a breakout space in the gallery if audience members need time away from the main event.

FAMILY FRIENDLY

Theatres are not traditionally seen as a baby or child friendly space but here at Theatr Brycheiniog we are on a mission to change that. Our programme regularly includes shows for younger audiences and we do our best to make sure that we provide the ideal space for your family to feel comfortable and enjoy some live theatre. These shows are also listed as 'relaxed performances', this means that not only do we 'relax' the conventional rules for our audience but it means you can 'relax' and enjoy the performance too.

Babes in arms under two attend free of charge.

Theatr Brycheiniog is proud to support the HYNT Scheme. Members of the scheme are able to bring a carer for free to most performances (excluding hires). HYNT believes that art and culture is for everyone and if you have an impairment or a specific access requirement, going to the theatre should still be easy and accessible.
